

Baseballs contain cork (from trees), wool (from sheep), cotton (from cotton plants) and leather (from cowhide).






Did you know that without agriculture, baseball is impossible to play?

Farmers grow food that all people eat. Corn flakes come from corn. Many other cereals are made from rice, wheat, & oats.






Toothpaste gets its flavors from herbs (like mint), spices (like cinnamon), or fruit (like orange, lemon, or apricot).






Crayons are made from soybean oil.

Mac the Moose is here to tell you about all the amazing products that come from agriculture.






Farmers grow the grains that you find in bread. They also grow apples, peaches, strawberries, tomatoes, carrots and more!
